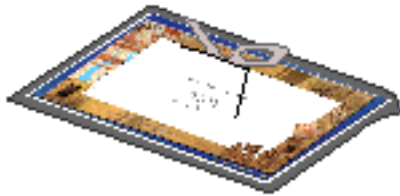


Photo frames

How to Build Them

1. Download the Frame you selected.
2. Open with Acrobat Reader.
(If you don't have this program, download it from the site)
3. Print the frame on any type of paper.
4. Cut the outside border of the frame.
5. Glue the printed page to a thin cardboard, cut the cardboard 1.5cm larger than the frame all round. Now cut over the dotted line in the middle as shown below.



6. Glue a piece of transparent plastic sheet (same size as the printed frame) under the printed frame, to protect your photos.

7. Cut the sides of the frame as shown below and fold them backwards glueing together the bottom two corners, to form a pocket.

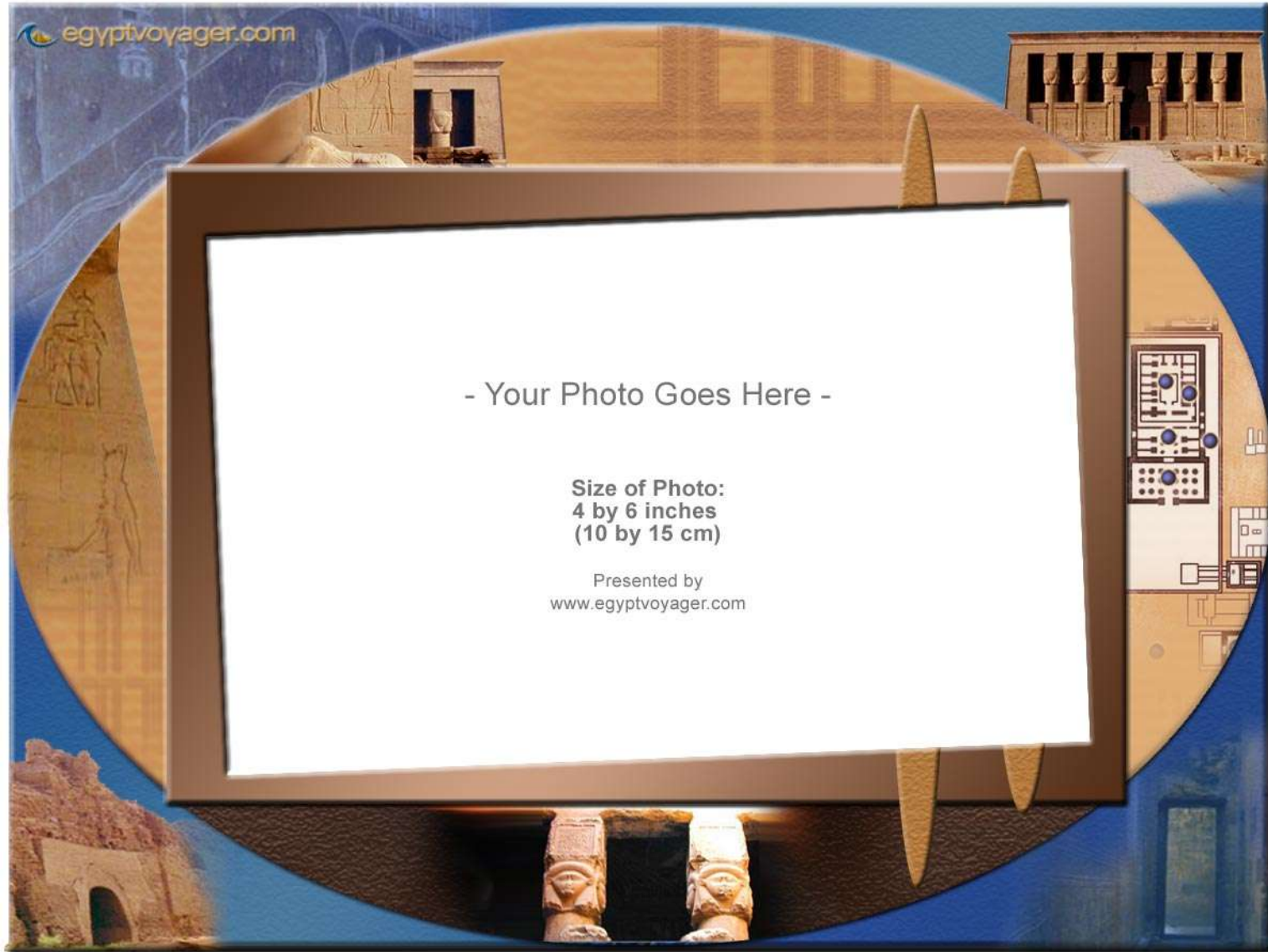


8. Cut a thick cardboard slightly smaller than the frame to form a backing. From another piece of thick cardboard cut the shape in figure 2.
9. Fold and glue as indicated.
10. Mount the frame by sliding the photo (mounted on a piece of thin cardboard same size of frame) in the frame. Finally, slide in the back of the frame.
11. Enjoy your new Egyptian Photo Frame.

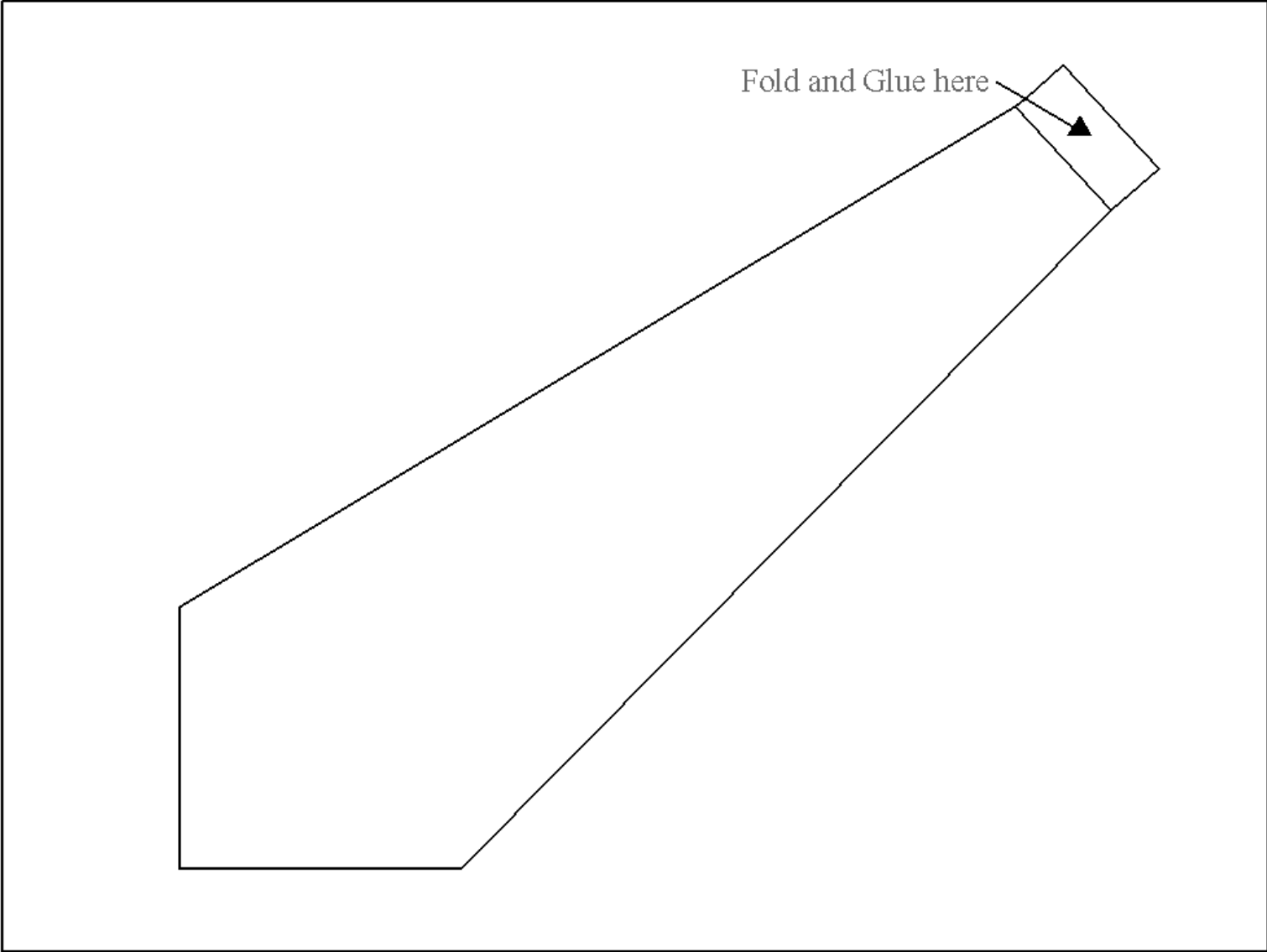
